THOUGHTS FOR MEDITATION

The Psalmist speaks of being stressed, maligned, slandered, oppressed. You might read Psalm 3 because this Psalm, 4 is a carry on from Psalm 3. Traditionally David is suffering from his relationship with son Absalom. Think about your own family relationships. How and when have they been strained? What did you do about it? How did these familial strained relationships carry over into your relationships outside family boundaries? Think about the church family. Have you ever suffered strained relationships with anyone within the/your church? What did you do about it?

The Psalmist says that historically God gave him space to breathe and lament. God continually gives space to do more of the same. The Psalmist infers that God was faithful to him amidst the ongoing distress caused him and will again find refuge and strength in the One who has always proved faithful. Is this your relationship with God? Do you find God always faithful? The Psalmist believes that God's life provision is more than sufficient, and is grateful for it. Furthermore, at the end of the day the Psalmist gives God his daily troubles and rests in God's abiding care. The Psalmist is able to sleep peacefully, soundly because God is praiseworthy. Is this your reality? As an old friend of mine used to say, *If not why not*? The Psalmist asks God to shine upon him and then goes to sleep believing he will dream well, and awake ready for the new day coming. May it be so for each of us. Amen.

PRAYER

Merciful God, your love and care is everlasting and always trustworthy because you are our trustworthy God. We thank you. This is our reality. At times we may feel alone and afraid, and neglected, but help us remember that you have promised never to leave us nor forsake us, but to grace us with your presence. We are your children, and you are our ever-present Resurrected Lord. Bless your holy name.

Forgive us where we have grieved your heart because of our waywardness, broken relationships, and neglect of responsible living. Thank you for your merciful forgiveness and renewed opportunity to think and act again.

We bring your world before your throne of grace. We acknowledge that it is a violent place, fraught with calamity and seemingly overwhelming problems. Give us renewed sense to perceive you in the midst of it, not only as suffering servant leading us to follow, but as the living God enabling us to live in you on behalf of your world.

We give you, our leadership. Guide and influence them through your gracious Holy Spirit. We give you the little, least, last, and lost who have fallen by the wayside. May they know your merciful care. We give you sick and suffering inhabitants of this earth. May they know your mercy and healing care. We give you those who grieve. May they know your everlasting promise of fullness in Christ. We give you the saints who have walked this vale of tears amidst the joys of your creation and now experience lasting peace. Be pleased to bring us with them into your heavenly habitation world without end. And teach us to pray. Our Father... Amen.
